What's Needed:

White card stock (60lb+) 1.5 - 2.0 inch safety pins



Plastic or wire hangers

(Use child for 4T & under: adult size for 5+)



Quart, gallon & XL clear storage bags



ਠ Clear packing tape




Painters/masking tape

No Printer? No Problem!

When you finish creating your tags use the "Print PDF" option and save the PDF file. Printing your tags at an office supply store will save you ink and time. Don't forget to ask them to cut your tags!

STEP 1: GATHER YOUR ITEMS

Children cycle through a new wardrobe every 6 months, so it's no surprise you feel overwhelmed. It's time to gather everything they no longer wear or use. Check seasonal guidelines regarding what's in and what's out for each event.

STEP 2: ORGANIZE

Grab 3 totes or baskets and label them: **KEEP. SELL. TOSS** (Have extra boxes or trash bags available)

- **KEEP** items that you aren't ready to get rid of yet.
- **SELL** items you want to sell. (Spring or Fall)
- TOSS items that don't meet JBF standards.

Decide which tub each item should go in.

- When you're done, set aside the **KEEP** bin for now. Take the **TOSS** bin to your local charity, repurpose the items, or throw them away.
- Separate the items in the **SELL** bin into Spring and Fall piles. These items are ready for Step 3.

OW TO KNOW WHAT TO SELL



The newer it looks, the better it sells. Plan to clean clothes, shoes, equipment and toys.



Sell clothing and shoes in current styles and fashion. Make sure they're the right season!



Toys, games and puzzles must be sold as a complete set without missing pieces.



Compliant

Safety guidelines apply to selling a car seat, stroller, baby equipment and toys. Check https://www.cpsc.gov for recalls.







STEP 3: PRICE & PREP

When you sell at JBF, you are in control of the price of each item. You also decide if it goes half price during our discount sale times. If the item doesn't sell, you can either donate the item to our local charity partner, or you can pick it up.



We recommend pricing at 1/3 of retail! Ask yourself, "What price would make me buy this item and brag about it to a friend?"

Price non-clothing items (Toys, Baby Equipment, Books, Games, etc.)



at 30-50% OF retail price

Bundle Items to Save Time

Create sets or bundles. Put an outfit together, or a set of same-size onesies. Bundle 6 pair of socks together, or several superhero figures. Shoppers love it, and you only have to create one JBF tag!

Prepping your items



TOYS & GEAR

Tips and Tricks:

- Tag is attached securely (won't fall off) &
- All pieces secured together (won't separate; tape bags closed)
- Small, like items can be bundled together in zip lock bags. Misc. items should not be put together in zip lock bags.
- Painters tape should be used on books, puzzles and on wood toys.











CLOTHING



Hanging & Tagging Clothing

Put most clothing on a hanger. Bundle onesies, socks, infant mittens & hats, as well as accessories in clear self-sealing bags. Attach JBF tag with safety pin or tagging gun.



Hanger Direction

Be sure the hanger hook opens to the left, like a question mark. Attach JBF tag to front of item.



Tagging Gun

Tagging guns are optional to use, but if you do, USE CAREFULLY. They can permanently damage fabric. If

you use a tagging gun to attach JBF tags, only puncture the garment tag or an inside seam so that you do not damage the fabric. If using safety pins you can still pin to the existing center tag or on the right side while facing the garment.

All items must be clean and fully working!




Where to Create Your Tags

Now that your items are inspected and bundled, it's time to log in to your JBF Profile and enter your tag data.

Creating Tags

Include brand, colors, number of pieces included

You choose the price

Choose the category that fits best (leave blank if you can't decide)

Indicate size for clothing and shoes

A check mark here will allow your item to sell at 50% off on Half Price Day

A check mark here will allow your item to be donated if unsold

This feature is if you have more than one of the exact same item and want to create several tags at once

TIP! Talk-to-Text

If you are entering tags on your mobile device, use talk-to-text to go even faster.



Print Your Tags

Print tags on 8.5"x11" white cardstock. Tags print 9 per page. Make sure to check boxes by the tags you want to print.

Drop Off





All Consignors must sign up for a drop off appointment! These appointments will open in August.

Now that your items are tagged, you'll want to pack items **organized by type and size** so that your Drop Off process is easy and fast.

Seller Drop Off for JBF Ann Arbor SUNDAY SEPT. 22 5-8:30PM MONDAY SEPT. 23 10AM-8PM WASHTENAW CO FAIRGROUNDS

- Plan for 60-90-minutes to drop off your items. Longer if you have 250+ items to drop off. You will enter in the last building (Building G) and work your way through all the buildings. Don't worry, there is a system to make this work smoothly!
- You will hang clothing on the racks by gender and size based on the smallest size on the tag. We have rolling racks you can use to help with this! All other items will be dropped in "Zones" by general category and the team will get them to where they go.
- All large items that are too big to carry go to Building A or B and will be inspected at drop off for cleanliness and by our Safety & Recalls Station.
- For your Large Items, we will attach a yellow ticket to the items which makes it easier for shoppers to purchase your items during the sale
- Before you leave make sure to get your paper presale tickets from the check out table! You get two tickets to shop on Wednesday, Sept. 28.

WHAT TO SELL CLOTHING

FALL

Item Limits: Total of 500 items. No Maternity clothing items, see teen limits, 75 items of girls/boys infant clothing NB-12month, Onsies must be bundled with something else, 25 clothing accessories (socks, hats, hair accessories)

Long-sleeved items: onesies, shirts, dresses









Leggings long pants jeans









Fleece pajamas winter pajamas winter sleepers









Shoes, snow boots rain boots

Crocs









Fall & winter jackets winter accessories









Swimsuits and swim diapers for indoor fall swim class (No other swim items)









ALL holiday outfits Halloween, Thanksgiving Christmas, New Years Easter...







NO THANK YOU ITEMS

There are some items we know we cannot sell right now. Please save them for spring.

X tank tops

X sundresses

X summer themed

X camp shirts

X shorts

X spring skirts

X summer dresses

X short pajamas

X flip flops

X summer accessories

Short sleeve shirts are allowed in limited quantity. Please save most of these for the spring sale.



WHAT TO SELL ITEM LIMITS

FALL

Maximum: Total Item limit of 500 items (ONE TAG equals ONE ITEM so when you bundle that is one item.) Minimum: 50 items or 5 large items. 1 large item = 10 items

Infant Girl Clothing NB-12 month 75 tags | Bundled items count as one tag



Infant Boy Clothing NB - 12 month 75 tags | Bundled items count as one tag





Basic onsies must be bundled with other onsies, pants or shirts of the same size.



No Maternity clothing for the fall sal.e Juniors clothing must be current, within 3 years old - see teen guide

Clothing Accessories - 25 items (socks, underwear, bras, hair accessories, hats, sunglasses)





Bedding: 5 item total unless new with tags. . No bedding sets or comforters. Nothing larger than twin size. No bed pillows.



Room Decor: No breakable room decor

No Party Supplies | No DVDs No Swim accessories, only swimsuits

No bags of bundled miscellaneous items. Only like item bundles Example: Bundle of infant rattles is accepted. Bundle of random craft supplies or toys is not. Item limits help YOU be successful.
